My husband and I live reasonably close to the University here in Toowoomba and have often been awoken by undue noise and abusive language in the early morning hours. Beer bottles have been thrown into our garden or left broken on the footpath. Consequently, we are left to clean up this mess as many children use our footpath on their way to and from school.

We are senior citizens and feel this type of behaviour is unnecessary and uncalled

for. Therefore the trading hours for such venues should not be extended.
