QUEENSLAND ELECTORAL REFORM

Reference is made to your letter of 11 November 1999.

Basically our Council would agree with the proposed amendments. I would, however, like to specifically mention our support for No 3 Voting Material – this amendment would greatly assist voters and take the onus of responsibility off the institutions.

Secondly, I would like to record this Council's support of No 5 – Canvassing etc in or near Polling Places. Discretion with regards varying the distance party workers should be from the entrance of the pre-polling booth would be most welcome. It is not only inclement weather that causes problems, but there may be instances where it is impossible to stand 6 metres from the entrance in the case of a pre-polling booth being located in an office block for example.
