Committee Members,

Re. QUEENSLAND ELECTORAL REFORM.

May I respectfully refer you again to the very detailed previous Submissions made relating to this Subject
Especially to the :- 1988 - "Tony" Fitzgerald Corruption INQUIRY ;associated E.A.R.C. and C.J.C. Reform process;
and the Carruthers ;Connolly Ryan Inquiries ;and more recent Brisbane Regional Electorate Boundaries e.g. Lytton.

For they deal with the present matter under Review.

Especially I Submit :- the following 3 matters be considered now :-

1-Every ELECTORATE in Queensland should have the SAME EQUALITY of POPULATIONS
of ELECTOR \ PERSONS .

(For EVERY Queensland Member of the Parliament DEMOCRATICALLY should have an EQUAL RESPONSIBILITY
to REPRESENT an EQUAL NUMBER of ELECTOR \ PERSONS .

Queensland in this instance should ADHERE to the NATIONAL STANDARD .))

2-With a WEIGHTAGE + - NOT EXCEEDING 5% ;using the new COMPUTER technology now available .

(For -IN OUR DEMOCRACY - such as :- the LAND AREA ; FAUNA ; FLORA ; and FORESTRY -
must HAVE NO RELEVANCE to the REPRESENTATION of ELECTORS where ONLY PEOPLE VOTE !)

At the same time -it is up to the Parliament to PROPERLY EQUIP EACH Member of Parliament ;so that they
WOULD BE ENABLED to DIRECTLY and INDIRECTLY provide the ACCESS and SERVICE when and where
is reasonably necessary . E.G. via such as Teleconferencing,Free Phone and Postage , Shop Front Offices,Extra Staff,
Transport -even if it includes such as 4 wheel drive, Boat, Helicopter, Small Plane , etc ,Radio , T.V. and Print ,etc.

3- Every Member of Parliament who is ELECTED AS A POLITICAL PARTY MEMBER by their ELECTORATE ;
MUST NOT BE PERMITTED TO VOTE IN PARLIAMENT in such a way so that SUCH VOTE WOULD BRING
ABOUT TH E DOWNFALL OF THE GOVERNMENT .

(Any such disaffected Member of Parliament must RESIGN as a Member of the Queensland Parliament without delay
and the SPEAKER of Parliament is to Request the SAME POLITICAL PARTY to name a suitable PARTY MEMBER
to be APPOINTED by the PARLIAMENT to COMPLETE the TERM of the RESIGNED MEMBER .

This replacement system (similar to Senate Replacements) could apply to any Resignation for any reason -e.g.Death ,etc.
Such a REPLACEMENT SYSTEM would save the cost and disruption caused by such as a BY-ELECTION.)
