SUPPORT FOR REFERENDUM ENTRENCHMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROVISIONS

Council at its meeting of 15 October 2002 resolved as follows:

"That the Chief Executive Officer be requested to advise the Legal, Constitutional and Administrative Review Committee of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland of Council's strong support for the referendum entrenchment of any proposed Queensland constitutional provisions relating to Local Government."

In accordance with the above resolution, I am writing to add Council's support to the referendum entrenchment of the system of Local Government in Queensland.

As your committee report highlights, Local Government in Queensland is a recognised third tier of Government with an extremely close working relationship with the State Government, which is uniquely Queensland in nature.

This working relationship has been based on a common sense approach of mutual respect and co-operation on an equal standing.
