## SUPPORT FOR REFERENDUM ENTRENCHMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROVISIONS

Council at its meeting of 15 October 2002 resolved as follows:
"That the Chief Executive Officer be requested to advise the Legal, Constitutional and Administrative Review Committee of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland of Courcil's strong support for the referendum entrenchment of any proposed Queensiand constitutional provisions relating to Local Govemment."

In accordance with the above resolution, I am writing to add Council's support to the referendum entrenchment of the system of Local Government in Queensland.

The referendum entrenchment of a system of Local Government would ensure this equal standing in negotiations is never called into question when short-term political agendas temporarily disrupt this relationship.
