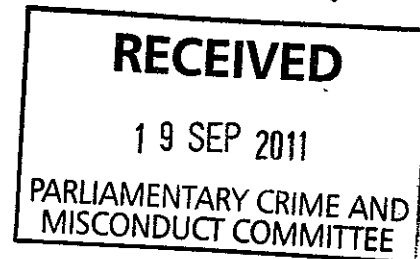


REVIEW OF CRIME AND MISCONDUCT COMMISSION ACT 2001

We write on the advice of the Queensland Policy Union of Employees.

We agree with the view put forward by the Office of the Queensland Police Union Solicitor that the review of the *Crime and Misconduct Commission Act 2001* be undertaken in the same forum as the *Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 2000* Review. We found the PPRA Review process to be useful, coordinated and an excellent way in which to engage relevant stakeholders. We agree with the Queensland Policy Union's proposal that the Crime and Misconduct Commission should be required to table any proposed amendments, present them before a committee and allow for discussion with relevant stakeholders.
