A identifiable taxi company is much preferred with clearly marked, safety checked cars, professional uniformed drivers, security cameras, vehicle tracking, push button alerts, etc. The thought of my mother being put into an Uber car, just for the so-called 'convenience' of booking and paying for a 'ride' from mobile phone is not worth the risk.

If Uber is allowed to operate in Queensland it must be on a 'level playing field' with the professional taxi industry. Please think carefully about your proposed amendments to legislation.
