



DEAR COMMITTEE SECRETARY,

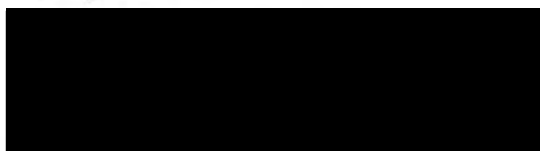
I AM WRITING TO VOICE MY CONCERN REGARDING THE CURRENT
