I have to seek for income to pay my continues commitments that would not stop even though I was unemployed I would not eligible to get support from Centrelink. I have to earn money to feed my family.

I could choose to be homeless person with the rest of my family but my determination to earn income through UBER is possible. By why UBER drivers have been punished with all the fees and charges?

After minus with our current expenses that as an UBER drivers have to bear, our net income per hour is around \$5 to \$10. I have to spend for 10 hours on the road per day to get \$50 to \$100 per day to support my family.

UBER drivers are those who are having difficulties in life to earn money. If all of the UBER drivers have other options to make money they will definitely quit as UBER drivers but all the UBER drivers have to find a way to support their loved ones.
