① Human Cadaver Bequests.

People "Will" their body to Universities & possibly other research organisations and seems to be a need for cross reference and co-operation with such operations i.e. other unidentified cadavers, to tap into these possible sources of transferable organs - If such is possible so that cadaver preservation procedures required for anatomical sciences do not prevent a possible organ transplant.

My cadaver is subject to such a bequest to U of Qld under file n^o *attention of* ; Bequest Programme Manager
& could check with my *Donor card*

② Possibly there exists a need for listed organ donors to have an appropriate detail medical examination at suitable intervals update, with the information listed and cross reference to organ source. Such medicals being carried out at donor's local hospital or clinic; No cost to donor.

③ Organ Donation to have PRIORITY over anatomical sciences but possibly incorporated with the longer term requirements of teaching, even becoming part of such, prior to cadaver preservation.
