We don't have a problem with the lease arrangement as it stands at present, as we are able to manage the lease area as part of the freehold property. If there were additional restrictions placed on it or grazing rights were removed as has been suggested at times then we would not be able to provide the protection against fires and weed infestations that we currently do. The Forestry leases in this area contain significant stands of rosewood which is harvested by licenced timber cutters for fence posts, wild fires destroy rosewood and other tree species.

## · My suggested solutions to rectify this issue/s are:

Allow Graziers to continue managing these leases as they have done without too many onerous restrictions, this will help preserve them for the future at no cost to the Government and ensure that this valuable resource is maintained.
