My main issue/s with the current vegetation management framework is:	<p>Overly complex process to obtain a development application/permit for vegetation management</p> <p>The length of time taken to obtain a development approval/permit for vegetation management</p> <p>The length of time to utilise a permit/development approval is too short (currently 5 years) and doesn't allow for long-term property planning</p> <p>Incorrect mapping</p> <p>Overregulation of activities that are routine and essential to the management of my property (for example clearing for fence lines, firebreaks, roads, or infrastructure)</p> <p>Over-administration or administration of vegetation management by inexperienced departmental staff</p> <p>Ignoring experienced land managers advice</p>
If I could propose further changes to the legislation these changes would include:	<p>Emphasis should be on soil management as trees regrow however soil cannot be replaced in the short or even medium term.</p> <p>Dense areas of trees in a water course will often cause soil erosion. Selectively thinning of trees in this situation allowing grass cover will often reduce or eliminate soil movement down the catchment.</p>
