

My main issue/s with the current vegetation management framework is:	Overly complex process to obtain a development application/permit for vegetation management The length of time taken to obtain a development approval/permit for vegetation management The length of time to utilise a permit/development approval is too short (currently 5 years) and doesn't allow for long- term property planning Incorrect mapping Overregulation of activities that are routine and essential to the management of my property (for example clearing for fence lines, firebreaks, roads, or infrastructure) Over-administration or administration of vegetation management by inexperienced departmental staff Ignoring experienced land managers advice
If I could propose further changes to the legislation these changes would include:	Emphasis should be on soil management as trees regrow however soil cannot be replaced in the short or even medium term. Dense areas of trees in a water course will often cause soil
	erosion. Selectively thinning of trees in this situation allowing grass cover will often reduce or eliminate soil movement down the catchment.
