I have Remnant Vegetation found on my property Yes




My main issue/s with the current vegetation management framework is:

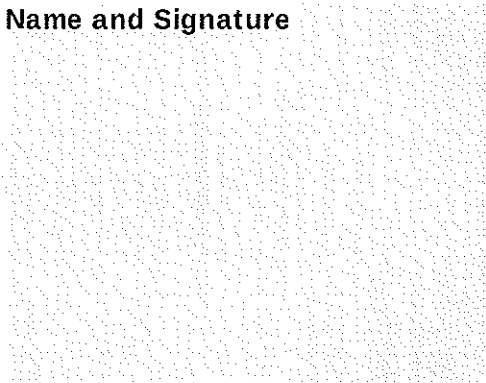
