My main issue/s with the current vegetation management framework is: Over-administration or administration of vegetation management by inexperienced departmental staff

If this Bill is passed it will mean the following for my property in terms of improved productive, environmental and/or social aspects: I have a 2390hectare grazing property in a 24 inch rainfall area with a 240 hectare area of loam/sandy loam which at the moment is almost useless as grazing country. In the immediate area there is 10,000 hectare+ of this country and on my property it is officially not of concern. This soil type is essential as developed grass country in order to help cope with the regular extended dry periods and droughts which heavy soil types aren't suited to.
