<b>My main issue/s with the current vegetation management framework is:</b>	<p>Overly complex process to obtain a development application/permit for vegetation management</p> <p>The length of time taken to obtain a development approval/permit for vegetation management</p> <p>The length of time to utilise a permit/development approval is too short (currently 5 years) and doesn't allow for long-term property planning</p> <p>Incorrect mapping</p> <p>Overregulation of activities that are routine and essential to the management of my property (for example clearing for fence lines, firebreaks, roads, or infrastructure)</p> <p>Over-administration or administration of vegetation management by inexperienced departmental staff</p> <p>Restrictive overlay mapping on freehold land of less than 400 hectares is detrimental to the viability of the property</p>
<b>If this Bill is passed it will mean the following for my property in terms of improved productive, environmental and/or social aspects:</b>	<p>Development applications/permits would be less complicated ensuring the time taken in completion and approval would be considerably less reducing costs.</p> <p>It is essential for the landowner to have correct mapping to ensure that proper land management is carried out. Amendments to incorrect maps should not be at the landholder's expense.</p> <p>Clearing of fence lines, firebreaks are routine farm management practices. Self-assessable codes will remove the need to obtain a permit for such practices ensuring efficient farm management.</p>
<b>If I could propose further changes to the legislation these changes would include:</b>	<p>Riparian areas should only be on esplanades/reserved land.</p> <p>Selective logging is an integral part of farming practice and needs to continue for future viability.</p>
