

## **Inquiry into e-mobility safety and use in Queensland**

### **Submitter Comments:**

This submission covers electric motorbikes with pedals (not ebikes with power-assisted pedalling, limited to <25km/h), which are increasingly a cause of serious carnage on our roads and walkways. These devices are not bicycles despite the pedals afixed to their hubs.

Electric motorbikes:

- should not be allowed on shared walkways
- should not be allowed on public beaches
- should be registered for road-use
- both rider and passenger should wear helmets

The regulation is currently in place to control the use of these devices so increased enforcement is required.

The Australian Design Rules provide a good definition of an ebike, so people selling an electric motorbike as an ebike should be prosecuted.
