Submitter Comments:

I am a mobile crane operator around the Gold Coast. The cranes we drive on the roads are quite wide and require a lot of concentration to drive safely. Ebikes cannot be seen well at night and often ride freely switching from footpath to road recklessly by teenagers. They should be licenced if ridden on the road and have sufficient lights on them so that they can be seen. I do not want to find myself in a situation where I have clipped one with the wide passenger edge of a mobile crane. Or if one of them rides in front of me and I don't have time to stop the 25 tonne mobile crane.
