I have withnessed many near misses, mostly school students, who have no idea about the rules of the road. Unfortunately a scooter rider/s are going to die and a driver with a licence will have to live with the trauma for the rest of their life. It is not worth the risk of driving when school is starting or finishing and indeed at any time, especially in built up school areas.
