The simple lack of awareness by users and the government of this fact has lead to the current situation. The most disturbing part of this situation is lack of concern by police, council and politicians in even enforcing current laws. I have heard those in power dismiss enforcement as being not attractive and the fun police. I have witnessed police watch these devices pass them by at speed dangerously swerving between pedestrians without helmets every time we are lucky enough to have a police presence in Surfers Paradise. Everybody deserves to feel safe walking on a footpath. Those with disabilities deserve the right to walk safely without being harassed and bullied on their local footpaths.
