As a road user, I have a problem with young unlicenced people riding e-bikes on the road or footpath. A lot of these riders have no training in road rules and no regards for safety of both themselves or other road/footpath users. I would like to suggest either or all of the following: some form of licensing for the users which requires testing of their road rules knowledge and requiring the user to obey the road rules some form of registration and insurance to cover any damage or injury caused by the rider of the e-bike whenever an individual purchases one of these e-bikes, either for themselves or another person, that the purchaser signs a statutory declaration that they will be responsible and liable for any damage or injury caused by the rider of the e-bike to any other person or property. The statutory declaration must be lodged with the appropriate government department.
