Rules require enforcement plus rider rule training in schools Australian regulation on imports and sales similar to other motorised vehicles. Qld allows cycles to share walkways and pavements 12km/h speed is reasonable for shared use. There should also be a weight limit applied for example similar to a normal bicycle+250W battery with single rider (ie no two up or even three up). All e-vehicles, power above 250W, speed capable above 25km, multiple rider capacity, weight above 30kg should all be road registered and meet road regulations including mandatory third party insurance. Actually similar to petrol driven motor vehicles.
