I frequently walk from Burleigh to Tallebudgera and observe the following: no helmets, speeding, lack of knowledge of road rules and lack of consideration of pedestrians. The Tallebudgera Creek pedestrian Bridge has a sign for bike riders to dismount. I have never once observed this. Bicycle riders are courteous, ting their bell and don't take up room. E-bikes don't warn of their approach and take up a lot of space. It's an accident waiting to happen. Perhaps e bikes should be registered and riders sit a road file test applicable to use of footpaths and roads.
