Regarding e-scooters I would like the following suggestions be considered: (1) e-scooters be registered (for a small fee) so they can be readily identified at the time of an accident and or misconduct by the rider; (2) The rider be at least 16 years of age and have parental permission and responsibility for the use of the scooter;(3) The rider must, by law, wear a helmet while riding the scooter and make doubling prohibited at all times; (4) Speed limit be reduced while riding on a footpath when sharing the space with pedestrians;(5) The e-scooters be purchased from a reputable dealer with a warranty and recorded on the registration application.
