I would like to see included in the review the following, listed below are mode of electric transport under the new laws and regulations because all have the ability for users to go fast in silence which is dangerous to others in the public, plus they have the ability to leave the scene of unlawful usage quickly and silently. Electric motor bikes, electric skateboards, electric scooters, electric pushbike. They do have a place in society if used correctly. All should be speed limited to max 15km per hr except (electric motor bike). All are not allowed on roads over 50km per hr. If they are under the age of 16 they must be occupied by an adult 18 years or over. A bike helmet is suitable under all these conditions listed above. Penalties should be: First offence - a warning to person and legal guardians {no fine} warning is legally recorded as an offence. Second offence - a fine of 100 dollars to legal guardians (if the young person is 16 or under - over 16 the rider receives the 100 dollar fine and confiscation to storage for one month. Third offence - total confiscation and destruction such as hooning laws. Electric motor bikes. In relation to electric motor bikes they can only be ridden on approved motor bike or motor cross parks or a person's own property.
