Good afternoon Chair

As parents of Zeke Hondow (8yrs) who tragically lost his life whilst riding his e-bike home from school on the 30 October 2025, we would like your committee to consider the below dot points during the emobility inquiry.

- Stop high powered and fast e-motorbikes from riding on bikeways and footpaths. (This is believed to me a major contributor to Zekes tragedy)
- Stop the sale of illegal e-motorbikes – retailers should clearly mark the bikes as illegal and not be allowed to sell them to parents and children.
- Educate parents not to buy the illegal e-motorbikes as they can only be operated off road on private property.
- Should not be able to modify e-motorbikes to travel above 25km/h
