I am concerned that Victoria Park's unique assets will be eroded or destroyed by olympic developments which can be placed in a less sensitive cultural, heritage environment, thus removing Victoria Park's Heritage value and sacred site value for Indigenous peoples.

I am concerned about the removal of public safeguards by effectively exempting Olympic venues and villages from laws that apply to other Queensland projects.
