I am writing to implore you to please keep your election promises and stop the clearing of old trees. Many of our native (and often endangered) wildlife depend on it. You are hopefully aware that the greater glider, although quite small by comparison, prefer to live in very tall eucalypt forests, often with a circumference of 50cm or more. These can only be found in old forests with large trees, and it is necessary that clearing be kept to an absolute minimum.

Please also consider protecting high conservation value regrowth revegetation areas.
