VEGETATION MANAGEMENT BILL AMENDMENT RESPONSE

The economy of our Tablelands Regional Council area is based primarily on our Agricultural industry, whether it be the highly productive areas of our Golden Triangle, our undulating high rainfall areas; or our more extensive grazing land toward the south west.

It is our understanding that the proposed amendments to the State Government's Vegetation Management Bill, the 18th amendment to this Bill since it was first introduced in 1999, will put at risk the ability of these blocks to produce to their potential and substantially limit the ability for expansion of productive land within our region.
