Submitter Comments:

I would like to urge the committee to ban the sale and use of glue traps in Queensland. The collateral damage to our native wildlife is devastating, and there are plenty of other far less harmful (and more effective) ways to manage and control insects - personal repellent, repellent devices, bait traps, electrical lure traps, insect screens and so on. There simply is not a need for glue traps that cannot be fulfilled by some other means with less harm to wildlife. Worse, glue traps actively attract wildlife that comes to feed on the insects trapped on them and thus fall victim to their sticky embrace, potentially dying a long slow death by dehydration or starvation whilst injured by the trap - a most inhumane death. Please act now to rid Queensland of these fauna killers.
