## ERADICATION OF RETAIL SELLING OF GLUE TRAPS

I only wish, in hind sight, that someone could have forewarned me. To those who don't check their glue traps, I can only assume the misery of an animal suffering a long painful death.

Please take my plea into consideration when undertaking the review of the QLD Animal Cruelty law to prevent ongoing trauma to both animal and human alike. As a past resident of Queensland, it would be a great achievement to know that Queensland takes a proactive lead in eradicating glue traps. Ideally, it would be great to have them banned throughout Australia.
