Not much has changed in the past 20 years. I believe what is really needed is a Royal Commission into the treatment of animals and how we care for our wildlife. But meanwhile we want to bring your attention to the lack of review of impacts on wildlife, particularly the lack of mentioning glue traps.I also understand that just under 1500 submissions were received for the entire cruelty laws review, so I need you to please take the objection to glue traps seriously.
