

Estimates Question Taken on Notice

MR M BERKMAN ASKED THE DEPUTY PREMIER, MINISTER FOR STATE DEVELOPMENT, INFRASTRUCTURE, LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PLANNING AND MINISTER ASSISTING THE PREMIER ON OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES INFRASTRUCTURE (HON S MILES)

QUESTION:

I understand that the Brisbane City Council has not applied to the federal government for funding for the Toowong to West End Green Bridge or any other bridge aside from the two that are already underway, at Kangaroo Point and Breakfast Creek. Minister, can you please confirm whether BCC has applied to the state government for funding for the Toowong to West End Green Bridge?

ANSWER:

I can confirm the Brisbane City Council has not requested funding from the Department of State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning (the department) to construct the Toowong to West End Green Bridge.

The department has consulted with the Department of Transport and Main Roads, the Department of the Premier and Cabinet, Queensland Treasury and the Department of Tourism, Innovation and Sport and these agencies advise they have not received a request for funding from the Brisbane City Council about this matter.
