I have been made aware, that once again Tolls are set rise on the toll roads in my area.

I would like to know why for so many years now, the South side of Brisbane and Logan have born the brunt of tolls while the North side has always been free? A prime example is the Gateway Motorway, with a toll on the Southside, but none on the Northside. This is so very wrong!

The Logan Motorway has caused great strain on the area that I live. Because of the heavy tolls, truck drivers use Johnson Road through Forestdale to avoid paying tolls, this subjects every one living in what was a quiet leafy out of the way suburb to horrendous traffic problems, especially at commute times, it is noisy and increasingly regular road accidents occur along the Forestdale stretch.

The road infrastructure in my area is very poor, especially with the influx of people that the government are allowing to settle here. In particular, the Mt. Lindesay Highway, which even the RACQ has recognised as having the most dangerous intersection in Queensland, and yet all we hear about are satellite cities being planned and built in this corridor and never any concern about how they will impact the area.

Because of previous bad planning, a lot of work has been needed to alleviate the problems at the Logan Motorway Browns Plains junctions, this road should never have been a toll road from the beginning and to increase tolls to pay for your mistakes is wrong.

I would ask you to seriously looks at the increasing burden that you are inflicting on the residents of this area.
