I would like to make a brief comment to this Inquiry.

My wife and I have been using Brisbane's tollroads regularly since inception. We probably average 4 toll-trips each week.

The utility of the roads is very useful, providing both great connectivity as well as reliable timing and certainty of journey timing.

Indeed, I would welcome the adoption of a far more extensive tollroad network in Queensland, particularly as it is apparent that ever more demand is being placed upon existing infrastructure and the capacity of government to provide it is apparently limited. Hence, "user-funded" infrastructure needs to be adopted far more extensively and politicians of all parties should be strong advocates of user-pay models, rather than using it as a political football.

I would also observe that we have never had a single issue with payments/billing on any of the toll roads in southeast Queensland. Payments are seamless and accurate and transferring the accounts to new vehicles have always occurred without problems.

I trust that this is useful to the Committee in its considerations.
