I wish to voice my concern at the cost charged for toll roads across Queensland and especially tolls operating in the Greater Brisbane area.

When the Gateway Bridge first opened the government of the day said the toll would never need to be more than \$1. This they said would be enough to pay for the bridge and then the toll would be abolished. Toll prices have since been added to many roads, bridges and tunnels around Queensland.

Unfortunately the price of tolls has risen so today the cost of crossing on the Gateway is almost \$5 and on other roads their toll prices are even more. While I can appreciate the cost of wages and other charges to keep the bridges operating should be increased, the more than doubling of the toll charges is far too exorbitant.

An full enquiry should be able to reveal the true cost of operating the toll roads (including their maintenance) and arrive at a more suitable toll price for each road, bridge or tunnel.
