Dear Sir/ Madam,

My belief was that Toll roads in Brisbane were built to alleviate traffic congestion. This is not happening as the toll costs are far too high and motorists are avoiding using tollways. Consequently the traffic congestion on Brisbane roads is worsening, so the tolls are having the opposite effect to what they were designed for.

I believe the maximum toll cost should be \$3.00 per toll point.

My vehicle is registered commercially. I am a Commission Agent and use it for work.

Commercially registered vehicles pay about double the toll charges of a privately registered vehicle. I have no way of passing this cost on, so just have to wear it. You can understand why I avoid tollways!

I believe the toll costs for commercially registered vehicles should be the same as the equivalent privately registered vehicles.

If toll charges are reduced, the usage will increase and the owners of the tollways will see their profits grow.

Reduce the toll charges now or Brisbane traffic will grind to a standstill.
