Our jh holden cruze 1.4 litre turbo has cut out while driving on highway doing 100 km, which is very dangerous experience as a x firefighter i have never had so many difficulties with vehicle like the holden cruze ,now know as has replaced 4 FAULTY turbos 2 water pumps as recalls, How is a dangerous vehicle such as holden cruze being passed for sale to consumers as they have had recall after recall. We need QLD transport to have stringent rules to selling dangerous vehicles Manufacturers need to be accountable. We pay taxes on these vehicles before we can drive them we pay rego we pay insurance, we as consumers have no protection against lemon vehicles as it stands now, QLD government of the day need to be counted to look into what is going on in vehicle industry in gld as we the public are getting sold dangerous vehicles, the manufacturers dealers seller needs to be held accountable for vehicles they are selling to private business public as these vehicles are massive investment for everyday family we need insurance and a warranty for our vehicle into 2nd warranties for vehicles . example when you buy a tv you have 2 years warranty them extended for further 5 years tv price \$500 .A vehicle \$15000 to \$ 20000 3 month warranty how does this make common sense we need QLD PARLIAMENT to stand up for there state for people of qld who own vehicles to know that your hard earned investment money is driving your dollar further no that we have protection from our government that have passed these vehicles for sale in gld when you drive out of car dealers ., we need car reform.
