Clause 57 - (2 d) " any requirements prescribed by regulation about the operation and testing of a photographic detection device were compiled with for the specified device at all material times"

- **CILTA:** Clarification required what is meaning or intent of "ALL Material Times" with relation to the "operation and testing of a photographic detection device"
 - Upon reading we could not identify the meaning or intent; we recommend further clarification is required

Clause 58 – No Issues

Clause 59 - 120D Photographic or video evidence about the use of approved seatbelt, "In the absence of proof to the contrary" –

- (2) A The vehicle depicted in the image or video is taken to be moving but not reversing or stationery but not parked: and"
- a) To remove any doubt or ambiguity if the vehicle was traveling forward, we recommend this clause inserts the following
 - i) To remove any doubt the image of the vehicle shall have the speed of travel when the image was taken in not wearing the seat belt

Clause 59 – 120E Photographic or video evidence of mobile phone use

(2) In the absence of proof to the contrary the vehicle depicted in the image or video is taken to be moving, or stationery, but not parked

CILTA: Clarification required and Recommendation – Further meaning of stationery but not parked is required as this can be read many ways over various circumstances as to what stationery is – but not parked
