Hello

I have been advised the Government is opening an inquiry into vehicle safety and standards
I wish to offer some comments

Should Queensland consider annual safety checks on cars at registration time to check on basic items as tyre and brake condition.

Some of the deaths on roads may be attributed to poor car maintenance.

I am told the Dept of motor transport has designated crews doing this

Having lived in Qld for eleven years I have never had my car stopped for an inspection

Annual checks could cover more using our roads.

With hooning this may be a way to catch drivers with illegal car modification including mufflers exceeding the legal noise level

Maybe a law that restricts manufacturing of loud exhaust systems and any modifications to the manufacturers specifications could be implemented. If these restrictions are part of the current law they are not working which could mean they are not being policed.

Laws are not much use if they are not enforced.

Hope to hear the outcome of the inquiry in due course
