

MINUTES

Meeting of the PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEE OF PUBLIC WORKS held in Room A17, Parliament House, on Monday, 28 August 1989, at 3:30 p.m.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mr. A.C. McPhie, M.L.A. (Chairman); Mr. H. Palaszczuk, M.L.A. (Deputy Chairman); Messrs L.A. Ardill, D.E. Beanland, C.J. Berghofer, T.S. Hynd and D.J. Slack, MM.L.A.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: The minutes of the previous meeting, having been distributed prior to meeting, were taken as read. On the motion of Mr. Slack, seconded by Mr. Ardill, the minutes were adopted, with amendment, as a true and accurate record of the previous meeting, recording that a letter from Dr. Grigg relating to the hearing on 24 July had been received and noted, but had been omitted from the previous minutes.

BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES: No replies had been received from the Director-General, Premier's Department in relation to the Kingaroy Airport or to the Committee's request for details of public works being undertaken in excess of \$2M.

CORRESPONDENCE: In addition to list of correspondence already distributed to members, the following was presented:

Inward -

1. Review of Buffer Zone requirements for the proposed Wolffdene Dam.

2. Letter from the Minister for Justice and Attorney-General and Minister for Corrective Services in relation to the relocation of the proposed Women's Prison at Wacol.
3. Printout from the Parliamentary Library of references on desalination and effluent treatment.
4. Letter and report from the Minister for Water Resources and Maritime Services in relation to the Bundaberg Irrigation Scheme.

Outward -

1. Memorandum from the Chairman to Committee members enclosing a summary of the Buffer Zone Report and in relation to proposed meeting days.

On the motion of Mr. Hynd, seconded by Mr. Beanland, the inward correspondence was received and the outward correspondence confirmed.

KINGAROY AIRPORT: As a reply had not been received to the letter to the Director-General, Premier's Department, this matter is to be held over until the next meeting of the Committee.

IRRIGATION SCHEME: As members had not had time to consider the detailed information and report on this project, further consideration held over until next meeting.

2. Mr. David Evans, Secretary, Brisbane and Area Water Board, in relation to resumptions of land in the Wolffdene area.
3. Mr. T.D. Fenwick, Commissioner, Water Resources Commission, in relation to the Buffer Zone and policy matters, etc. regarding the proposed Wolffdene Dam.

Main Roads Department reports on the area and summary of current work being done by the Water Resources Commission in relation to the proposed dam to be obtained prior to the hearing.
