Agreed that the draft report for the period from 1 July to 19 October 1989 of the Committee be adopted with amendment to the section on referrals.

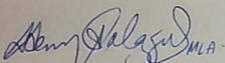

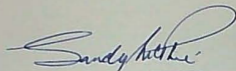
GENERAL BUSINESS:
