Arthur Miller summoned to attend rescheduled Earle Haven investigation hearing on Friday 20 September

The Queensland Parliament's Health Communities, Disability Services and Domestic and Family Violence Prevention Committee has summoned Mr Arthur Miller, Managing Director of People Care Pty Ltd, to appear before its rescheduled Earle Haven investigation public hearing on Friday 20 September 2019 at 10.00am.

The Chair of the committee, Mr Aaron Harper MP said, "The committee had previously summoned Mr Miller to attend its public hearings into the closure of the Earle Haven residential aged care facility on 11 September and 16 September."

Mr Harper MP said that Mr Miller's request to be excused from attending these public hearings on medical grounds was granted by the committee.

"For the residents and their families, staff, and others who were affected by events at Earle Haven, we need to hear from Mr Miller the details of how and why this happened", he said.
