Extracted from the third party account as published in the Moreton Bay Courier 19th July 1860

The President took the chair at 25 minutes to 5 o'clock, and opened the proceedings with prayer.

INTERNAL COMMUNICATION.

A message having been received from the Legislative Assembly requesting the attendance of the hon. Captain O'Connell, the hon. Mr. Compigne, and the hon. Mr. Bigge, for the purpose of being examined before the select committee now sitting on Internal Communication.

Captain O'CONNELL moved—That leave be granted, and the motion having been carried, a message was forwarded to the Legislative Assembly, intimating the same.

JOINT STANDING ORDERS.

A message, borne by Messrs. Royd and Taylor, was received from the Legislative Assembly announcing the names of the hon. members appointed to act on the Joint Standing Orders' Committees. (We gave the names in a former report.)

PRIMARY EDUCATION BILL.

On the motion of Captain O'CONNELL, this bill was again recommitted for the purpose of making certain verbal alterations.

The alterations having been agreed to, the house resumed, and the report was received.

The third reading was fixed for the following day, and the house adjourned at 5 o'clock until the next day at half-past 4 o'clock.
