THE PRESIDENT took the chair at 25 minutes past 3 o'clock.

PAPERS.

Dr. HOBBS laid on the table a commission from His Excellency the Governor, empowering the President of the Legislative Council to fill the Office of Administrator of the government in the event of the death or absence of his Excellency.

Also, a paper relating to postal communication.

Both papers were ordered to be printed.

ALIENS BILL.

On the motion of Dr. HOBBS, the report from the committee of the whole on this bill was adopted, and the third reading fixed as an order for the next day.

FENCING BILL.

Dr. HOBBS moved the second reading of this bill, and in doing so, briefly explained its provisions, much to the same effect as the introducer of the bill in the other house.

The motion was carried, and the committal of the bill was fixed as an order for Wednesday next.

The house adjourned at half past 3 o'clock, until the next day at 3 o'clock.
