Address to His Excellency Colonel Blackall, on his Assumption of the Government of Queensland.— Prorogation of Parliament.

ADDRESS TO HIS EXCELLENCY COLONEL BLACKALL, ON HIS ASSUMPTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF QUEENS-LAND.
