The POSTMASTER-GENERAL said that though there was not any important business on the paper, yet, to-morrow, he expected that certain resolutions regarding the resumption of lands in the settled districts of the colony would be sent up from another place; and in order that they might be placed on the paper, and to give honorable members time to think over them before discussing them in the Council, he should like to get a House next day. Therefore, instead of regarding a further adjournment over the following week, which had been mentioned at the last sitting, he should move that the House adjourn until to-morrow, at the usual hour.
