SATURDAY, 1ST FEBRUARY, 1879.

On this day, prior to the day appointed for the meeting of the House, a Proclamation, of which a copy is subjoined, was issued in a Government Gazette Extraordinary :—

“ PROCLAMATION by His
 “ Excellency Sir ARTHUR
 “ EDWARD KENNEDY, Knight
 [L.S.] “ Commander of the Most
 “ Distinguished Order of St.
 A. E. KENNEDY, “ Michael and St. George,
 “ Companion of the Most
 Governor. “ Honourable Order of the
 “ Bath, Governor and Com-
 “ mander-in-Chief of the
 “ Colony of Queensland and
 “ its Dependencies.

“ WHEREAS the Parliament of Queensland now
 “ stands Adjourned to Wednesday, the fifth
 “ day of February, 1879, and it is expedient to
 “ Prorogue the same: Now, therefore, I, Sir
 “ ARTHUR EDWARD KENNEDY, in pursuance of
 “ the power and authority in me vested as Gov-
 “ ernor of the said Colony, do hereby Prorogue
 “ the said Parliament to Wednesday, the nine-
 “ teenth day of March, 1879.

“ Given under my Hand and Seal, at Gov-
 “ ernment House, Toowoomba, this first
 “ day of February, in the year of our Lord
 “ one thousand eight hundred and seventy-
 “ nine, and in the forty-second year of Her
 “ Majesty's reign.
