The PRESIDENT announced the receipt of messages from the Governor, conveying His Excellency's assent, on behalf of Her Majesty, to the following Bills:—A Bill to enable the South Brisbane Gas and Light Company (Limited), incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1863, to light with gas the city of Brisbane and its suburbs, and for other purposes therein mentioned; a Bill to further amend the Pacific Island Labourers Act of 1880, and to put a limit to its operation; a Bill to consolidate and amend the laws relating to the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors by retail, and for other purposes connected therewith.

The House adjourned at five minutes past 4 o'clock.
