KABRA TO MOUNT MORGAN
RAILWAY.

APPOINTMENT OF SELECT COMMITTEE.

On the motion of the HON. A. H. BARLOW, it was resolved—

1. That the plan, section, and book of reference of the proposed branch line of railway from Kabra to Mount Morgan, Central Railway, in length 13 miles 50 chains, to be constructed under the provisions of the Railways Guarantee Act of 1895, as received by message from the Legislative Assembly on the 4th November, be referred to a select committee, in pursuance of the 111th Standing Order.

2. That such committee consist of the following members, viz.:—Mr. Gregory, Mr. Thorneloe Smith, Mr. Buzacott, Mr. Clewett, and the mover.
